Select the "Future Meeting" button to schedule a meeting.

You can login back in and click on the meetings button and update or change the conference information.

You should get an email confirming your invitation to the meeting. The meeting number is the number at the end of the Join link. (see next slide)

The moderator controls who is presenting during the conference.

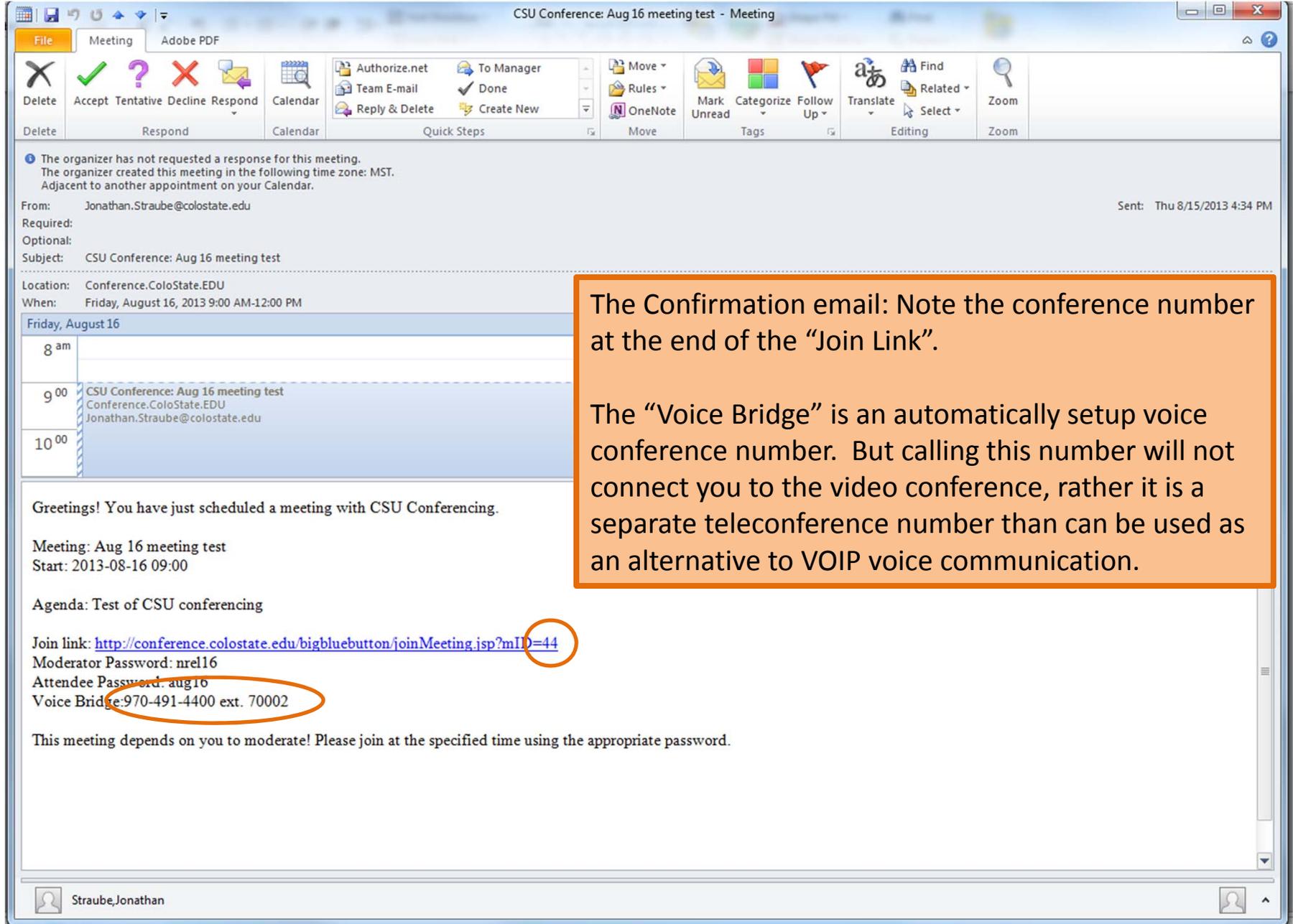
